NOTICE OF RACE

CLASSES: All catamarans between 16 and 22.5 feet in length having a current US Sailing Portsmouth Number. Only those boats in their original One-Design configuration are eligible. Modifications requiring Portsmouth "correction factors" are not allowed.

ENTRIES: Entry forms must be filed with the race committee prior to 10:00 a.m. October 9, 2010. For pre-registration discounts, entry forms must be received at the MBYC office or post marked by September 15. See attached entry form for fees.

SCHEDULE: Competitor's meeting will be held Saturday 10:00 on the lawn north of the clubhouse. Three to four races are schedule for Saturday and three on Sunday, time and weather permitting. The racing will be in the ocean off Mission Bay (weather permitting). The first warning will be at 12:00 noon each day. The start of the second race will be as soon as possible after the completion of the first race and so forth. A minimum of two races shall constitute a regatta.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing as amended and adopted by USSA, except as amended by the MBYC Sailing Instructions. Changes in sailing instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The official notice board is on the south side of the MBYC clubhouse.

COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The courses for these races will be prescribed in the sailing instructions but will likely include the windward-leeward courses with options for multiple laps with either windward or downwind finishes. There will be separate starts for each one-design catamaran class with a minimum of three entries. For all other catamarans there will be a spinnaker and a non-spinnaker handicap fleet and scoring will be by Portsmouth handicap. The Sailing Instructions for this regatta will be available no earlier than 8:30 am on Saturday, October 9, 2010 at the MBYC regatta registration table.

LAUNCHING: Two hoists and multiple beach launch locations exist at MBYC and overnight trailer parking is provided. Check in at front desk at MBYC for any questions and trailer parking location.

TROPHIES & SCORING: Trophies will depend on the number of entrants with one place awarded per three entries in the class. When fewer than six races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores. When six or more races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of all its race scores excluding her worst excludable score.

SHORE ACTIVITIES: Breakfast, a box lunch, and dinner will be available at MBYC for a reasonable cost. Beer keg to be provided after races.

MBYC RESTRICTIONS: No overnight camping within the club grounds. No motor homes or recreational vehicles of any size inside the MBYC gate. No pets allowed within MBYC. Empty boat trailers are to be parked along the west fence.
