NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES This event will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ADVERTISING This is a Category A event (no advertising).

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Harbor selections and resumes should be submitted with a completed entry form to Mission Bay Yacht Club by 14 June 2010.

3.2 Maximum number of entries accepted will be 10

3.3 All competitors must:

3.3.1 Be members of the U.S. Sailing Association,

3.3.2 Be members of a Yacht Club belonging to SCYA, a Southern California Sailing club belonging directly to US SAILING, a Community Sailing Program or other sailing organization which is a member of SCYA and US SAILING.

3.3.3 All competitors must have reached their 13th birthday, but not their 19th birthday during the calendar year.

3.3.4 Members of the same team must be from Area J Yacht Clubs

4 FEES

4.1 Entry (per team of three) \$175.00 (This includes the boat charter fee)

4.2 Non-refundable cleaning fee 25.00

4.3 Borrowed Boat Insurance \$ 75.00

4.4 Damage Deposit \$300.00

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Entry deadline: June 14 2010.

5.2 Registration will be from 09:00 am to 10:30 am on 18 June 2010 in the main dining room of Mission Bay Yacht Club. All fees must be paid at that time.

5.3 A competitors meeting will be held in the MBYC dining room at 10:30 am.

5.4 The warning signal for the first race is scheduled for 12:00 on 18 June.

5.5 Subsequent races will be as soon as possible.

5.6 There will be as many races as there are competitors unless time permits for a second round robin. The decision will be announced at the competitors meeting.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7 VENUE All races will be held in the Sail Bay part of Mission Bay, including attached coves.

8 COURSES The courses will be windward-leeward.

9 PROTEST Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

10 SCORING One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

11 SAFETY

11.1 A US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device shall be worn, properly fastened, at all times while sailing, except for brief periods while changing clothing. Failure to comply with this rule may result in disqualification or other penalty as deemed appropriate by the Protest Committee.

11.2 A boat retiring from a race shall notify a Race Committee vessel before leaving the course, or when that is impossible, the Club Office immediately after arrival ashore.

12 DISCIPLINE Per US SAILING regulation 5.03 no contestant shall use, either on or off the water, during any US SAILING Junior Championship event: marijuana or any other controlled substance, or alcoholic beverages. Additionally appropriate Corinthian behavior will be followed at all times. This regulation is in effect from date and time of arrival through date and time of departure from the locale. After a proper hearing the penalty shall be that the contestant be immediately removed from the regatta venue and sent home.

13 PRIZES The top team will represent Area J at the SEARS CUP in Mission Bay, San Diego.
